### ELIGIBILITY

The successful applicant will have their course fees for undergraduate study up to the value of **\$3,000** funded by Perrin Ag for the relevant academic year.

### SELECTION PANEL

Eligible applicants will be considered by a selection panel, comprising of two Directors of Perrin Ag Consultants Ltd. The selection panel will make their recommendation to the full Board of Perrin Ag.

### SUBMISSION DEADLINE AND AWARD ANNOUNCEMENT
